

## Learning from Home

During Term 2 parents are asked to keep their children at home where possible. Children with parents in front line essential work roles can attend school and also students who are unable to stay at home.

Due to family circumstances and health reasons, we have several of our teachers working from home to support our students' learning.

Staff have developed three ways to support learning from home during Term 2. The learning is aligned to our school wide agreed curriculum. As a general guide we would hope that your child undertakes 2 to 3 hours of study a week for each subjects.

## Online Learning

Students can access learning sequences and resources via CANVAS for all of their subjects. Once a week students can join an online conference with their teacher of each subject. They can get feedback at stages during their learning by emailing their teachers through CANVAS or by emailing their teachers. They can submit finished work via CANVAS. We have developed a number of instructional videos on how to access CANVAS. You can access these videos from our web site under the **Students** menu. Some aspects of learning through CANVAS can be undertaken using a smart phone, but a tablet or computer is the preferred device.

## Hard Copy Learning Packages

Hard copy learning packages for all subjects are available for students who cannot access online learning. These packages will be made available to students every two weeks. Students can submit completed work by taking a photo or a scanned copy of the work and sending it to their teacher via the email address provided or by uploading it to CANVAS. Note that we do not want the completed work physically returned to teachers.

## At School Delivery

Students who attend school will follow their usual timetable and attend classes with their usual teachers. If their teacher is working from home or is on sick leave, the student will go to the library for those lessons. In the library they will be supervised to undertake the online learning program for that class. Where it is possible, students may attend practical based subjects with another class if their teacher is absent from school.

## Year 9/10 Co-ed Classes

Our co-ed classes will be delivered using online and hard copy packages.

## Teacher Contact

Our teachers will maintain normal working hour during Term 2. They will respond to parent and students question during the hours of 8:30 am to 3:30 pm Monday to Friday.

## Parents Supporting Learning

We ask that you place priority on your wellbeing and the wellbeing of your children during these difficult times. Please set realistic expectations and don't get worried if your son does not do all of the work required. Some of the suggested learning activities may not suit your son or your home learning routines. Feel free to adapt and change things when required.
